### Hello Neighbor,

Estabrook Civic League members have recently been researching the lost history of the ECL building and property. Several recovered documents show that lots 25 and 26 on Robin Hood Road (formerly Simpson Road) were purchased on October 3, 1932 for \$10. The Hudgins-Dize Company, Incorporated recorded the sale on public records on October 22, 1932 at 9:55 a.m. Papers from the law firm Foreman, Pender, Parker and Dyer show the ECL, Inc. "was held firmly bound" unto The Mutual Building Association of Norfolk, Virginia in the mutual sum of \$1200 on August 20, 1932. Incorporation papers were received by the league on October 12, 1932.

Researching the history of the Estabrook Civic League building is a work in progress with many more documents and records to be reviewed. If you, a family member or a friend has any information about the League building, please contact ECL President Carolyn Foca at 757-386-1160. Early pictures, documented history or knowledge of past ECL events would be appreciated.

### THE MAY 5, 2020 GENERAL ELECTION IS BY ABSENTEE BALLOT ONLY

Request an Absentee ballot online at: www.norfolk.gov/706/Office-of-Elections by April, 28<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm. (The deadline to *register* for the May election is April 13, 2020.) You will need your Virginia Driver's License Number or Virginia DMV identification number to attach your electronic signature to the application. Under "<u>Choose an Absentee</u> <u>Option</u>," select: either your qualifying condition, OR with no qualifying condition select: "My disability or Illness".

If you don't have a Virginia DMV ID you may print the application, sign and mail it to the Office of Elections. Voters may also call: 757-664-4353, from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday. Curb-side voting services are available during regular business hours as well as sample ballots for Superwards 6 and 7 residents. (Due to COVID-19 restrictions, all City of Norfolk buildings are closed to the public until further notice.)

Information on the pendingJune 9<sup>th</sup> Republican Party Primary Election is also available on the above website. There is no Democratic Party Primary Election.

### LITTER CLEAN UP

Neighborhood Adopt-a-Spot and community cleanups have been sidelined by the City of Norfolk for now. However, there's no ban on your grabbing a plastic bag and picking up litter from the sidewalk, the yard or the gutter in front of your house. Let's try to keep our streets and sidewalks tidy during this unusual time. At least it'll be something to do for a few minutes. What's not to like?

### **BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR**

**BEING A GOOD NEIGHBOR** means knowing how to respect your neighbors, following city codes and managing the appearance of your property and your street. Here are a few of Norfolk City codes that apply to property owners:

- TRASH AND RECYCLING BINS may be set out no earlier than 5 pm the day before collection.
- TRASH CONTAINERS must be stored five feet behind the front plane of the building.
- **BLUE RECYCLING BINS** are only for paper, glass, and metal cans not for garbage, yard debris or plastic bags.
- BULK WASTE, including furniture, mattresses, appliances and up to four tires will be picked up on regular garbage collection days. You must contact My Norfolk to schedule pick up. CONTACT MY NORFOLK AT: 757-664-6510 or https://www.mynorfolk.org/#/homepage
- **VEHICLES** may not be parked on unimproved surfaces of the front, corner side yard or buffer yard of a lot in a residential district.
- PARKED CARS on a public street must be at least 3' away from a driveway entrance.
- INOPERABLE VEHICLES may not be parked on a public street.
- TALL WEEDS and grass higher than 12" are subject to City action.
- **ALL PROPERTIES** shall be free of solid waste, trash and debris.
- FATS, OILS AND GREASE (FOG) should not be poured into a sink drain or into a storm drain.
- **AUTOMOTIVE FLUIDS**, toxic substances or yard debris may **never** be put into a storm drain.







