Keeping History Above Water: Norfolk

Sunday, May 15, 2022

The 2022 Keeping History Above Water is being hosted by the Norfolk Preservation Collective, the City of Norfolk's Office of Resilience, and Old Dominion University's Institute for Coastal Adaptation and Resilience.

Keeping History Above Water®: Norfolk will expand the conversation around adaptation, resilience, and solutions to the impacts of sea-level-rise, recurrent flooding, and climate change on historic resources discussed at previous conferences. Sessions will explore the theme "Informed Communities Charting Solutions," and foster a collaborative and interdisciplinary discussion focused on implementing practical solutions, overcoming hurdles, and preserving communities in the process. This will be the ninth iteration of Keeping History Above Water, and is being hosted by the Norfolk Preservation Collective, the City of Norfolk's Office of Resilience, and Old Dominion University's Institute for Coastal Adaptation and Resilience, in partnership with Newport Restoration Foundation. The conference will take place May 15-18, 2022 at the Chrysler Museum of Art, and will include an opening plenary, 2 days of conference sessions, and optional tours, site visits, and networking opportunities.
