Protect Your Pipes This Winter!

Frozen pipes on your property are something to watch for in the winter months.

Here are five tips to help stop the problems before a potential burst. .

1. Wrap exposed pipes with insulating material. .
2. Locate your inside water shut-off valve, if your home has one, and tag it so it's clearly identifiable.
3. If your house has a crawl space, cover outside vents to prevent winter winds from freezing pipes.
4. Keep the garage door closed. Some water pipes are located under concrete garage floors.
5. Drip it. Keep water moving with a small trickle


