The pandemic has affected many families in so many ways that would have otherwise gone without a Thanksgiving dinner to share with their families. We were able to provide 23 meals to 23 families!

We would like to thank Dr. Pam Tatem, Principal at Coleman Place School and Mr. Warren Smith, for the distribution of the bags. And a special THANK YOU to Mr. Fred Gallup, 2nd V.P of our civic league for coordinating the project from beginning to end.

ABOUT THOSE STREET SWEEPING SIGNS YOU'VE BEEN SEEING. The City of Norfolk is temporarily making random changes to permanent street sweeping schedules. This is partially due to, you guessed it, the COVID-19 pandemic. Through the course of spring and summer, regular street sweeping was cancelled to keep neighbors and city employees safe. Now that regular sweeping schedules have resumed, some changes have temporarily taken place. For instance, in December, signs were posted in Estabrook and Coleman Place saying the sweeping would take place on the first Saturday of the month instead of the usual 2nd Thursday of the month.

Per Kyle Quick, City of Norfolk Street Sweeping Superintendent, this action was taken to help get the schedule back on track. Other normal delay factors include the weather, equipment issues, crew availability, and construction. Norfolk Director of Public Works, Richard Broad, cited another very important factor: parked cars along the curbs that block the street sweepers from doing their job. It's important to remember to move your car from the street on sweeping day. For the time being, when you spot a temporary sign announcing a different sweeping day, please move your car off the street.

STORM DRAIN UPKEEP – Quite a few of us learned a big lesson from the heavy rainstorm we had last month. Almost five inches of rain fell in Norfolk on November 12th, flooding many of our city and neighborhood streets. In some cases, the water came dangerously close to creeping inside homes. The high water also invaded many cars that were parked along street curbs. Why did all that rain not go into the storm drains? Simple answer, they were completely clogged by the collection of autumn leaves and other street debris. Norfolk City code says that homeowners are responsible for keeping drains in front of their homes clear of debris. The leaves have mostly fallen from the trees for now. However, if your property sits behind a storm drain, please think of your own property and that of your neighbors by keeping that drain clear.


