GREEN NOTE by Jeanine Lindberg. Heading into Fall, you can still have a lush, beautiful lawn without using expensive fertilizers or treatments which can harm our waterways. Aerating and laying down a quarter inch of compost in fall (and spring) provides valuable nutrients that keep your lawn healthy. Allowing 5% of white clover to grow adds nitrogen to the soil and eliminates the need to fertilize. Clover also attracts pollinators like bees. Setting your lawnmower at least 2 1/2 " - 3" high protects roots from drying out, helping grass to overcome weeds and pests. If dirt is showing through your lawn, that means roots are struggling to survive in full sun and high heat like we had this summer. Remember that any grass that falls onto the sidewalk or into the street must be swept up and put into a bag for yard waste collection. Lawn debris that goes into storm drains will clog pipes and pumps and could lead to flooded streets.

BUTTERFLY PLANT GIVEAWAY: About 70 butterfly plants were adopted in less than two hours at the Estabrook-Coleman Place plant giveaway on May 18, 2019. Guests were encouraged to take a variety of plants home to attract and nourish many kinds of butterflies and bees. Has the project been successful? Just look around the neighborhood and see all the butterflies that are flitting by.

STREET SWEEPING – To support Norfolk's street sweeping crews, follow these simple tips:

- Remove vehicles from the street on your neighborhood's schedule sweeping day. Leaving vehicles parked on the curb during street sweep hours will prevent the sweeper from effectively remove debris.
- Remove any large limbs or other debris that can damage the brushing mechanisms on the sweepers. For Assistance with bulk waste pickup, contact Waste Management at 664-6150.
- Never place yard debris, such as grass clippings or leaves in the street. Aside from this being illegal (it is a violation of Norfolk City Code) the debris can end up flowing into our waterways and contribute to water pollution and flooding.


